## **OSAS Version 7.6**

OSAS version 7.6 is scheduled for the release of most modules in August 2010, with Contractor Job Cost and certain developer utilities following in Q4 2010. ABS has participated in some training sessions for this release which includes 125 enhancements. While functionality may be limited based on the combination of modules licensed and client hardware capability, some of the enhancements that most impressed us are:

- The ability to report on an operator-selected group of customers/vendors/items/etc. rather than just a From/Thru range, then save that dataset for later reporting without re-selection;
- Ability to generate and save reports as PDFs to reduce the printing and storage of paper;
- Archive of documents which are emailed/faxed, with the ability to view/approve/edit them prior to delivery (faxing requires enrollment in a 3<sup>rd</sup>-party service at nominal cost);
- The ability to specify and retain fiscal period start/end dates for multiple years, including the ability to prevent (“lock”) posting to GL from each module (AP, etc.) for a fiscal year/period;
- Assignment of a “post run” ID to sets of GL postings so that all entries associated with a specific post can be easily identified;
- Role-based access codes to permit assignment of users to groups based on functionality required, rather than access assignments for each individual user, including the ability to grant/deny access to file maintenance sub-menu selections;
- Reconciliation of credit card “bank” accounts in Bank Reconciliation (requires Banking, Bank Reconciliation, and AP/PO modules);
- Wildcard lookups in Inquiry functions;
- Ability to import data (i.e., spreadsheets, time clocks, etc.) into GL Budgets, GL Transactions (journal entries), and PA Time Tickets;
- Enhanced plain-paper form printing including graphics, gray scale, mixed fonts and bar codes on selected documents;
- Line-item discounts percents can be entered by an operator in Sales Orders, rather than just limiting pricing to predetermined algorithms, with the discount % and amount printing on the invoice by line item, where applicable;
- PO history can be used as a template for subsequent PO entry;
- Each employee can have pay rates by earnings code (for each earnings code, if required);
- And MORE!

Remember that the current, and one prior release of each version of OSAS (and Traverse) are supported by Open Systems for enhancements and service pack updates. Upon release of version 7.6, version 7.0 will be “frozen” and no additional OSI updates will become available for it. While ABS will do our best to support such frozen releases, we encourage our clients to remain on the CES program to minimize migration, enhancement and support costs.
